



The Humanitarian situation remains dire in flood-affected areas of Pakistan, with widespread damage to physical infrastructure and ongoing harm to people and livestock. According to the NDMA's latest statistics, more than 1739 people died and 12,867 people were badly injured. In addition, numerous health facilities, schools, institutions, bridges, roads and infrastructure are badly damaged in various parts of the country.

INGO's played a vital role in flood response especially in relief, rescue, early recovery and mobilized \$150M for the flood-affected communities in Pakistan.




