

Heavy rainfall has been affecting southern and north-western Pakistan over the past few days, causing floods, and flash floods that resulted in casualties and damage. Pakistan has received 60% of total normal monsoon rainfall in just three weeks since the start of the monsoon season. Heavy rains have resulted in urban and flash floods, landslides, and Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOF) across Pakistan, particularly affecting Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Sindh Provinces.



## Muslim Hands

- Distribution of 420 dry food rations and 420 drinking water bottles in Basti Chandrawala, Basti Faiz, Basti Hamdani of Ranjapur, South Punjab.
- More than 600 patients availed free healthcare service in OPD and medicines in the free Medical Camps deployed in district Kemaari, Sindh. In collaboration with Pakistan Navy, trained Muslim Hands volunteers also catered the needs of beneficiaries. Elderly patients, children and expected mothers are being treated on priority.
- In Balochistan, MH team along with the Pakistan Navy is in the process to reach the far flung affected areas of Lasbela through aerial support. Meanwhile, a rapid assessment of flood affected areas is also going on to respond with all possible means of road transportation. Mainly, rescue relief and food security component will be catered in the initial humanitarian phase.
