


Heavy rainfall has been affecting southern and north-western Pakistan over the past few days, causing floods, and flash floods that resulted in casualties and damage. Pakistan has received 60% of total normal monsoon rainfall in just three weeks since the start of the monsoon season. Heavy rains have resulted in urban and flash floods, landslides, and Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOF) across Pakistan, particularly affecting Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Sindh Provinces.

Possible Impacts

As of 8th August 2022

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed that strong monsoon currents are continuously penetrating De Country and likely to become stronger from 10 August (Wednesday), under the influence of this system, following possible impacts are expected:

- Heavy rains may generate urban flooding in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Nowshera, Mardan, Faisalabad, Lahore and Gujranwala Dorn 8-12 August (Monday to Friday).
- Heavy Rains may also generate urban flooding in Karachi, Thara, Badin, Hyderabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad and Mirpurkhas Oom 11-13 August (Thursday to Saturday).
- Flash flooding is expected in Local Nullahs of Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Shakargarh, Sialkot, Narowal, Abborabad, Mansehra, Dir, Karak, Lakki Marwat, Bannu and AJ&K from 8- 12 August (Monday to Friday).
- Flash flooding is expected in Qila Saifullah, Loralai, Barkhan, Kohlu, Musakhel, Sherani, Sibbi, Bolan, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbela, Awaran, Turbat, Panjgur, Pasni, Jiwani, Ormara, Gwadar and Hill Torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan during the forecasted period.
- Catchment Areas of Rivem Jhelum, Chenab and Ravi may receive heavy downpour causing water levels to significantly rise during the forecasted period.
- Rainfall may trigger landslides in AJ&K, Galiyat, Murree, Chilas, Diamer, Gilgit, Hunza, Astore, Ghizer and Skardu during the forecasted period.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain more cautious during the forecasted period.


